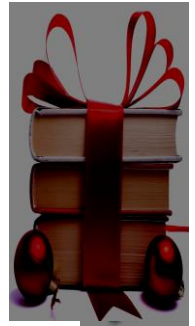

Dear Parade Entrants,

Thank you for your participation in our annual Christmas Parade. To make this time of year enjoyable and safe for all persons involved, we ask that you read and adhere to the following rules and regulations. For additional information, please call the Chamber at (662)226-2571.

- Do not throw candy, cups, or any other objects from your parade entry. This poses a serious safety hazard as children will run into the street to retrieve these items.
- All entries must be numbered while going through the parade route. If you do not have your number on your entry, you will be removed from the parade line-up. **NO EXCEPTIONS!!**
- Entries shall keep 50 feet from the entry in front of you,
- **No entry shall dress as a traditional Santa Claus.** Only 1 official Santa rides in the Christmas Parade. The Chamber will supply the Santa on a Chamber float.
- All participating bands must always stay in formation.
- Horses may enter parade providing they wear bags.

Route:

Line Up: Cars, Floats, Fire Trucks, and Bands line up on both sides of **Fairfield Avenue** beginning at New Life Fellowship Church (Old Baptist Church) to Elizabeth Jones Library/Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd (Highway 51). The parade will proceed North to the square and go around the square and down Green Street to the **GLAD Adult Education Center**. There will be officers and parade committee members stationed at joining streets to direct.

Parade Adjourns: At GLAD Adult Education Center (Old Lizzie Horn School). Do not stop before the end of the parade. You must go the full route of the parade.

Pick Up Area: GLAD Adult Education Center (Old Lizzie Horn School)

NOTE: if you choose to be in the parade, all rules **MUST** be followed. **No exceptions!!** There will be police officers stationed along route to enforce the rules and regulations. **Not following the rules may eliminate you from being in the Parade the following year.**
